



First Annual OCWSL FootGolf Tournament

1. Organize a team of 5 players (18 years or older) **OR** enter as a smaller group or individual and we will partner you with a team of 5. Teams can be all OCWSL players or a combination, just refer to registration for fee structure.
2. Assign a Manager, come up with a Fun Team Name, Collect the entry fee, Complete the registration form, and send it in by Nov. 1, 2020. (registrations received after Nov. 1 will fill tournament slots on first come, first served basis)
3. Start practicing (some FootGolf facilities listed below)
4. Create a Unique Team Uniform or not

FootGolf Tournament Guidelines

- The tournament WILL follow all current CDC & County Health Regulations in place for COVID19 at the time of the tournament. These specific health guidelines will be distributed to the team's manager within 3 weeks of the tournament.
- Individual & small group signups will be paired together to create a team of 5
- Team's Tee Times will be sent to the team manager 3 weeks prior to tournament
- Each player needs to bring their own standard #5 soccer ball
- NO Soccer cleats, indoor turf or tennis shoes are suggested
- Team uniforms are encouraged, but not required
